<b>Peregrino Merlot</b> <i>An elegant, full bodied wine with hints of chocolate and spice and aromas of cherries, pepper and cacao.</i>	£3.75	£5.50	£7.50	£21
<b>Pablo Cortez Malbec</b> <i>This ripe and lush Malbec has a lively red colour, a nose offering a mixture of berry and plum notes, a full bodied palate with smooth tannins and red fruit flavours.</i>	£4	£6	£8	£23
<b>Old Station Shiraz</b> <i>A deep red wine with aromas of blackberry and liquorice with cracked black pepper overtones. The palate is rich and rounded with soft tannins providing a lingering fruit-driven finish.</i>	£4.50	£7	£9	£25
<b>Los Vinateros Crianza Rioja DOC</b> <i>A rich, vibrant wine which has been barrel aged for at least 12 months, giving beautiful red fruit aromas and softly integrated oak. Broad on the palate with soft but well structured tannins and a rounded, long finish.</i>				£28
<b>Darriaud Cotes Du Rhone Villages</b> <i>Aromas of bramble fruits with warm spice &amp; soft vanilla oak. Smooth well integrated tannins that hold the fruit flavours to a lovely long finish with plenty of depth and body.</i>				£30

<b>Prosecco DOC Spumante</b> <i>Typical crisp and delicate perlage, pale light yellow colour with a delicate nose reminiscent of peach, green apple with secondary notes of acacia and lilac. Fresh and light on the palate, with balanced acidity and a light body, the finish is persistent.</i>			200ml	£7.50
<b>La Fornarina Prosecco DOC</b> <i>A light straw yellow sparkling white with a fine persistent perlage and a fragrance that recalls wisteria and acacia flowers. A delicate wine slightly smooth and particularly fruity.</i>				£27
<b>Hush Heath Balfour Leslie's Reserve Brut Sliver</b> <i>Elegant purity, a linear focus and fresh acidity. Predominantly Chardonnay, with citrus, green apple and brioche flavours to the fore. The wine's distinctive aromatic and spicy character is in created with the addition of a small percentage of Pinot Gris to the blend.</i>				£60
<b>Chapel Down Rose Brut</b> <i>An elegant English Rose produced primarily from Pinot Noir grapes and aged for 2.5 – 3 years on lees. Delicate aromas of traditional red summer fruits and a great alternative to Rose Champagne.</i>				£70
